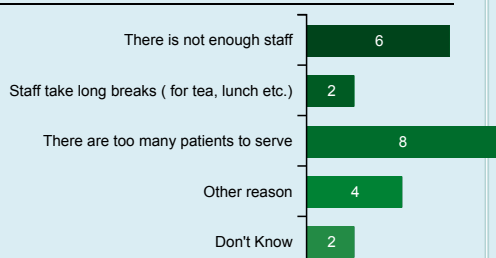

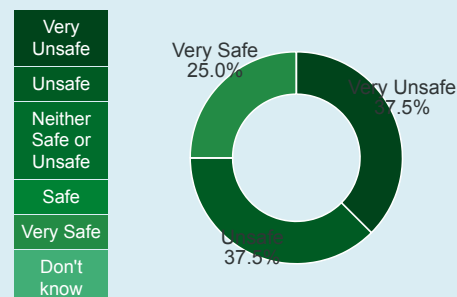

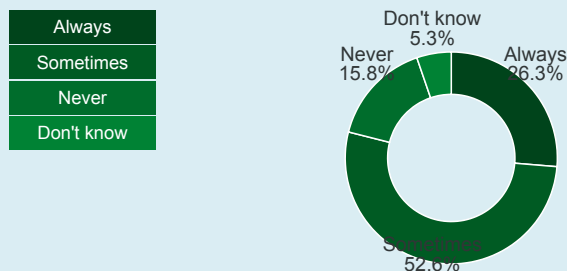

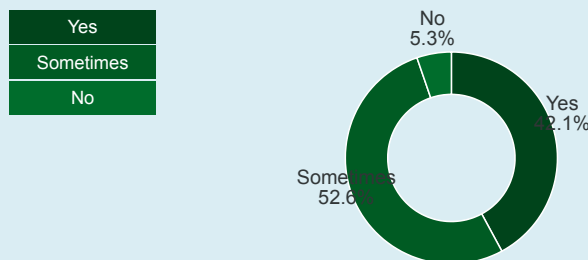

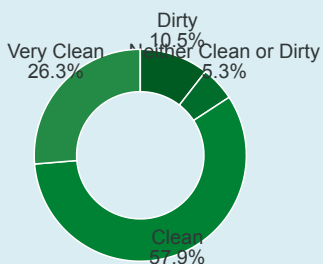

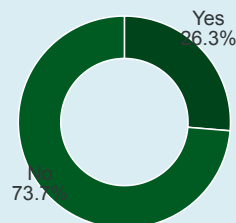

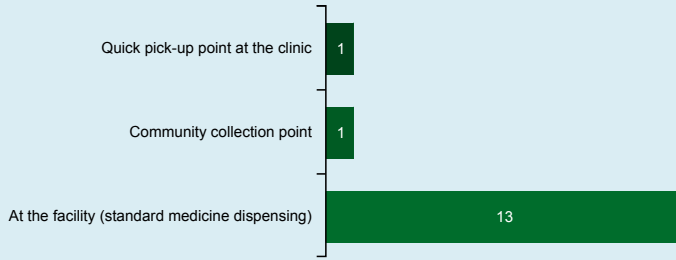

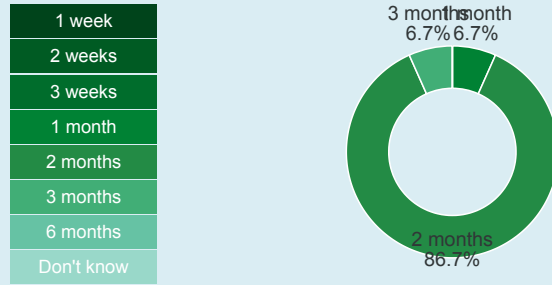
Where do you Collect ARVs?

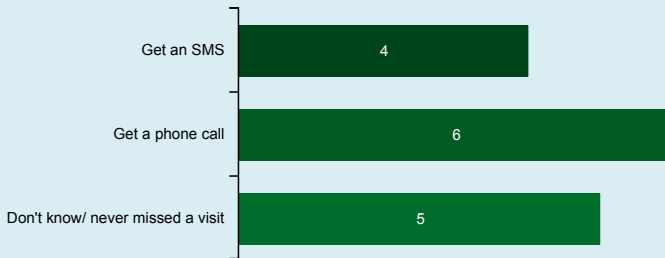
Length of HIV medicine refill?

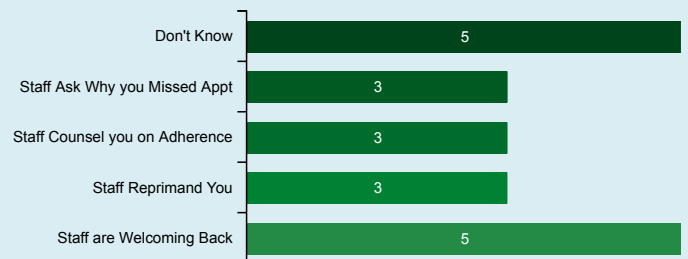
When Patients Miss a Visit to Collect ARVs:

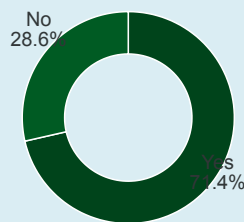

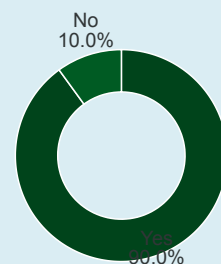

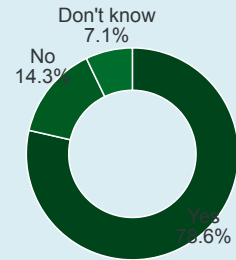
